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The Artist: BEN LEONE

Ben Leone, 29, was born and raised in Palm Beach. He spent much of his childhood around large construction projects during the decades-long, property-wide renovations and restorations of The Breakers, where his father is the longtime CEO. But the experience led him not to hospitality nor construction—but to art. "My father would take me out on construction sites almost every day after school; I spent hours upon hours checking out every detail," Leone shares. "Early on, I developed a deep appreciation for the physical nature involved with the process of design and fabrication, the synthesis of art and construction." Leone received his bachelor's degree in studio art, then spent five years under the tutelage of renowned artist Nathan Slate Joseph. He has since been developing his own body of work, focused on bridging the gap between art and architecture. His first large-scale public art installation—a five-story sculpture on two building elevations of the upcoming 345 Banyan residential highrise—will be unveiled in West Palm Beach by the end of 2022. "I love and cherish the act of constructing itself and embrace my urge to take standard practices and materials and give them new meaning," he says.
